Dr. Ruth Peever



Ruth Peever supervised the English program at APTS when we first moved there. Several years ago God laid on her heart the Ibaloi people in our area, and she began distributing picture Bibles for children in the area schools. The response was so positive that provincial school districts asked her to use the books in their values education program.

Ruth began a program of using local pastors to teach from the Bible in the values education program. The program has expanded into multiple provinces, and in the 2017-18 school year they taught **150,051** students in **1,343** schools using **2,603** volunteers. **35,638** children were saved. From this, **110** fellowship groups and **9,500** mentoring groups were started. Recently they have expanded to the island of Mindanao.

Angela Hughes



We first met Angela in Auckland, New Zealand, where she was Children's Pastor at a large Assemblies of God church. She moved to Baguio and became a student at APTS, and while there, she ask God to help her minister to the "most desperate." She saw children sleeping in Burnham Park in the center of Baguio. She took them food and told them she would be back next week, not knowing where the funds would come from. But God provided.

With others who joined her she fed them, read to them, gave them medicine, and prayed with them. Soon parents began coming. From that beginning, house churches began to be formed. Since that time **70** house churches have been formed ministered to by **90** trained Filipino volunteers in several provinces of the Philippines.

Her willing and obedient heart is making a tremendous difference for God's Kingdom.
