In 2014 Asia Pacific Theological Seminary set a goal of having 200 students, a goal that seemed impossible at the time. Our enrollment this past trimester was 242! Those students came from 30 countries in Asia, the Pacific islands, Latin

America, Australia, North America, Africa, and Europe. The countries with the largest representation are the Philippines, China, the USA, Myanmar, and New Zealand. In March, 40 students graduated and will return to their countries as pastors, Bible school
